

拉尔夫·恩洛博士获得范德堡大学(Vanderbilt University)高等教育管理学 (Higher Education Administration)博士学位。他在其母校哥伦比亚国际大 学(Columbia International University)领导教育工作长达二十八年,最后 六年担任教务长和常务副校长。他亦曾担任圣经高等教育协会(Association for Biblical Higher Education)主席十四年。退休后,他在自己协助创办的国际 基督教教育联盟(International Alliance for Christian Education)担任董 事会主席。

恩洛博士身兼领袖、教师、顾问数职,在神学高等教育领域服侍长达数十年,因 而对于领导力和侍奉有第一手的经验和独到的见解。他也积极参与国际基督教教 育的教导和顾问工作,足迹遍及世界各地。

Dr. Ralph Enlow is the retired President of the Association for Biblical Higher Education (www.abhe.org), a network of over 150 North American member and affiliate colleges that emphasize deep Bible engagement and spiritual development in community that helps students answer God's call to live life on mission with Him whether in the marketplace or the ministry.

Dr. Enlow chairs the Board of the International Alliance for Christian Education (<u>www.iace.education</u>), whose members include ABHE, 6 other partner organizations, and nearly 60 individual postsecondary institutions encompassing 6 continents, 21,000 institutions, and 5.6 million students worldwide. Before becoming ABHE President in 2006, he served for 28 years as an educational leader at his alma mater, Columbia International University (South Carolina, USA), culminating in a six-year stint as Senior Vice President and Provost. Ralph's extensive involvement in theological higher education includes service as a consultant, institutional self-study director, accreditation team peer evaluator, and chair of ABHE's Commission on Accreditation. A founding member of Global Associates for Transformational Education (<u>www.gateglobal.org</u>), he has been involved in international teaching and consulting in over a dozen countries. His service on ministry and non-profit governing boards includes The International Alliance Mission (TEAM - <u>www.team.org</u>), the International Council for Evangelical

Theological Education (ICETE <u>www.icete.info</u>), and the National Association of Independent Colleges and Universities (NAICU – <u>www.naicu.edu</u>).

His Vanderbilt University Higher Education Administration doctoral dissertation topic was entitled, Student Outcomes in General Education: A Comparative Analysis of Bible *College Ouality*. His scholarly publications and teaching interests include higher education accreditation, general education, leadership, biblical studies, and Bible college renewal. He has authored The Leader's Palette: Seven Primary Colors (2013), Ministry Education That Transforms (2018, co-authored with Robert Ferris and John Lillis), and Servant of All: Reframing Greatness and Leadership Through the Teachings of Jesus (2019). He is a contributing author to Evangelical Dictionary of Biblical Theology (1996); Leadership in Theological Education, Volume 1: Foundations for Academic Leadership (2013); Volume 3: Foundations for Faculty Development (2018); Transformed from Glory to Glory: Celebrating the Legacy of J. Robertson McQuilkin (2015); and The Encyclopedia of Christian Education (2014). He has also served on the editorial boards of Christian Higher Education and The Encyclopedia of Christian Education. Ralph and his wife, Valerie, married in 1977 and are blessed with two married adult children, Ralph III (Amanda) and Evie Piedt (David), and one granddaughter, Cordelia Marie Enlow. A second granddaughter, 5-year old Aria Grace Piedt, died by accidental drowning in March 2020.
